- WHEREAS, a native of Glen Head, New York, Ralph Della Ratta joined many of the other young 8 9 men of his generation and bravely served his country during World War II, deploying to the Pacific 10 Theater with the United States Navy; and
- WHEREAS, after he was honorably discharged from the service, Ralph Della Ratta returned to New 11 York and devoted almost four decades of hard work and loyal service to the New York Telephone 12 13 Company; and
- 14 WHEREAS, in 1985 Ralph Della Ratta moved to the Commonwealth for a well-earned retirement 15 and dedicated much of his time to following his passions and building many valued friendships in the 16 community: and
- WHEREAS, an antique clock collector, Ralph Della Ratta was a member of the National Association 17 18 of Watch and Clock Collectors, a nonprofit scientific organization that provides cultural and educational 19 resources on timekeeping; and
- 20 WHEREAS, becoming an avid and accomplished golfer, Ralph Della Ratta was a member of several 21 golf clubs in the Williamsburg area and once achieved two holes-in-one in the same year; and
- 22 WHEREAS, Ralph Della Ratta's son, Ralph, Jr., recognized his father by working to have a neonatal 23 unit at University Hospitals of Cleveland and the reception room at the City Club of Cleveland, the 24 oldest public speakers' forum in the country, named in his honor; and
- 25 WHEREAS, Ralph Della Ratta will be greatly missed and lovingly remembered by his devoted wife of 64 years, Mary; children, Susan, Carol, and Ralph, Jr., and their families; and many other family 26 27 members and friends; now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly hereby 28 29 note with great sadness the loss of Ralph Michael Della Ratta, a veteran and a friend to many in the 30 Williamsburg community; and, be it
