WHEREAS, the Rappahannock Choral Society, a 73-voice, audition-only regional chorus, is
dedicating its spring concerts on Mother's Day weekend, May 11 and 12, 2013, at Chancellor High
School's auditorium in Spotsylvania County to a special remembrance of the Civil War and the 150th
anniversary of the Battle of Chancellorsville; and

WHEREAS, some of the Rappahannock Choral Society's music will be familiar, some will be new;some songs will make the audience tap their feet to the beat and others will leave individuals with anache in their hearts; and

WHEREAS, the Rappahannock Choral Society is under the award-winning artistic direction of Linda
 Monner, with the incomparable accompaniment of Marilla Haas; and

WHEREAS, these concerts are made possible in part by a grant from the Virginia Commission for
the Arts and the National Endowment for the Arts and by the Rappahannock Choral Society, Inc., a
nonprofit corporation that is a partner of Spotsylvania County Parks and Recreation, a Partner in
Education with Spotsylvania County Schools, a member of the Fredericksburg Regional Chamber of
Commerce, and a member of the Arts and Cultural Council of the Rappahannock; and
