6	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 54.1-3707.1, relating to licensed
7	clinical social workers; educational requirements.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 54.1-3707.1 as follows:
10	§ 54.1-3707.1. Educational requirements.
11	The Board shall accept proof of the successful completion of the following as evidence of the
12	satisfaction of the educational requirements for licensure as a clinical social worker: (i) a master's
13	degree in social work with a clinical course of study from a program accredited by the Council on
14	Social Work Education, (ii) a master's degree in social work with a non-clinical concentration from a
15	program accredited by the Council on Social Work Education together with successful completion of the
16	educational requirements for a clinical course of study through a graduate program accredited by the
17	Council on Social Work Education, or (iii) a program of education and training in social work at an
18	educational institution outside the United States recognized by the Council on Social Work Education.
19	For the purposes of this section, "clinical course of study" means graduate coursework that includes
20	specialized advanced courses in human behavior and the social environment, social justice and policy,
21	psychopathology, and diversity issues; research; clinical practice with individuals, families, and groups;
22	and clinical practicum that focuses on diagnostic, prevention, and treatment services.
