A BILL to amend and reenact § 24.2-417 of the Code of Virginia, relating to voter registration cards.

Referred to Committee on Privileges and Elections

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 24.2-417 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 24.2-417. Persons to be registered.

Each registrar shall register every resident of his county or city who has the qualifications required by the Constitution of Virginia and this title and who applies for registration or transfer of his registration from another county or city in the Commonwealth at the time and in the manner required by law.

Any person, once properly registered, shall remain registered unless his registration is cancelled pursuant to Article 5 (§ 24.2-427 et seq.) of this chapter.

Each registrar shall issue and mail a new Virginia voter registration card to all registered voters in his county or city no later than October 1 of each year.
