9 10 11 12 13 14 15 16 17 18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25 26 27 28 29	WHEREAS, an independent audit found that the Virginia Department of Transportation had \$1.45 billion in unused funds; and WHEREAS, the Virginia Department of Transportation needs forward-thinking policies, creative management techniques, cost-saving strategies, and an increase in efficiency; and WHEREAS, the Virginia Department of Transportation should develop its working relationship with all agencies in the Commonwealth, including the Commonwealth Transportation Board, and with transportation planning organizations; and WHEREAS, transportation is an integral part of growth in the Commonwealth; now, therefore, be it RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the Joint Legislative Audit and Review Commission be directed to study the efficiency of the Virginia Department of Transportation. In conducting its study, the Joint Legislative Audit and Review Commission (JLARC) shall review Virginia Department of Transportation operations, data systems, bidding processes, project management, outsourcing, contract management, and working relationship with other agencies such as the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, the Commonwealth Transportation Board, and other transportation planning organizations and such other related matters as it may deem relevant and necessary. All agencies of the Commonwealth shall provide assistance to the Joint Legislative Audit and Review Commission for this study, upon request. The Joint Legislative Audit and Review Commission shall complete its meetings by November 30, 2013, and the Chairman shall submit to the Division of Legislative Audit Regular Session of

The executive summary and report shall be submitted as provided in the
