**3. Committee:** House Transportation

**4. Title:** Advertising within highway limits; agreements with Prince William County.

**5. Summary:** The Code of Virginia prohibits the placement of advertisement within highway limits and authorizes the Commissioner of the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) to remove the advertisements and collect the cost of such removal. The Code also allows the Commissioner to enter into an agreement with Fairfax County to allow the county to enforce provisions prohibiting advertising within the highway right of way and to collect associated penalties and costs. The proposed legislation would allow Prince William County to enforce the provisions and collect the fees.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Preliminary. See Item 8.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The provisions would authorize Prince William to retain fees associated with removing signs. It is not expected that the change would impact state resources.
