**4. Title:** Rappahannock River Basin Commission; reduces number of members.

**5. Summary:** This bill reduces the membership of the Rappahannock River Basin Commission from 34 to 32 members. The reduction in the number of members is due to redistricting in 2012 that resulted in the removal of one Senate district and one House of Delegates district from the Rappahannock River Basin area. The bill also reduces the number of members that constitute a quorum from 12 to 11.
