4. Title: Health care records; increases maximum copying fee that a health provider may charge

5. Summary: The proposed legislation increases the maximum fee that a health care provider may charge for retrieving, reviewing, and preparing copies of patient records in response to a subpoena duces tecum or a request by the patient, his attorney, or his executor or administrator. The maximum fee is raised from \$0.50 to \$0.75 per page for up to 50 pages and from \$0.25 to \$0.50 per page for documents in excess of 50 pages. The bill also raises the maximum search and handling fee from \$10 to \$20.
