3. Committee: Passed Both Houses.

4. Title: Unemployment compensation; disqualification from benefits due to loss of license or certification.

5. Summary: This bill amends the code to add the disqualification from unemployment compensation benefits due to loss of license or certification. It provides that an individual is ineligible for unemployment benefits if he or she has been discharged because of the loss or a failure to renew a license or certification that is required for a job.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill has no fiscal impact, as it simply codifies the Virginia Employment Commission's interpretation of the existing statute as reflected in its agency guidelines and policy directives.

11. Other Comments: This bill is similar to HB1382.
