**4. Title:** Assisted living facility or adult day care center; application for license to operate

**5. Summary:** The enrolled legislation provides that only at initial application, not renewal, would an investigation be made of the applicant's 1) activities, services, and facilities; 2) character and reputation, and 3) financial responsibility. The financial records of an applicant for licensure to operate an assisted living facility, adult day care center, or child welfare agency will no longer be subject to inspection if the applicant submits a current balance sheet and income statement accompanied by a letter from a certified public accountant certifying the accuracy thereof and at least one credit reference.
