**4. Title:** Assisted living facility or adult day care center; application for license to operate

**5. Summary:** The substitute legislation requires the Department of Social Services to investigate an applicant's financial responsibility at initial application for licensure as an assisted living facility, adult day care center, or child welfare agency. However, the financial records of an applicant will not be subject to inspection if the applicant submits an operating budget and one credit reference. The amendments also exempt the confidential proprietary information required by this Code section to be provided to the Virginia Department of Social Services (DSS) from disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act. The bill contains an emergency enactment clause.
