4. Title: Real Estate Board; authority to hear fair housing violations by real estate licensees.

5. Summary: This enrolled bill provides that the Fair Housing Board has no authority over a property owner or his agent or principal, who has engaged a real estate licensee to perform real estate activities within the purview of Chapter 21 (§ 54.1-2100 et seq.), which licensee has also been charged with a violation of the Fair Housing Law in the same case. The bill also provides that in no event shall the jurisdiction be split between the Real Estate Board and the Fair Housing Board on the same such case.
