4. Title: Registration expiration

5. Summary: This bill amends § 46.2-646 to permit the Commissioner to extend the validity period of an expiring registration if (i) the Department is unable to process an application for renewal due to circumstances beyond its control, and (ii) the extension has been authorized under a directive from the Governor. However, in no event shall the validity period be extended more than 90 days per occurrence of such conditions.
