**5. Summary/Purpose:**

Designates a portion of Interstate Route 81 between the Virginia/Tennessee line and Exit 118 as the "Congressman William Wampler, Sr., Memorial Highway." The Department of Transportation is to place and maintain appropriate markers indicating the designation of this highway. This designation does not affect any other designation heretofore or hereafter applied to this highway or any portions thereof.
