4. Title: Virginia Residential Property Disclosure

5. Summary: Authorizes any locality to designate one or more tourism activity zones as areas that may be used for special events, including parades, events requiring temporary street closures, and indoor and outdoor entertainment activities. An owner of residential property located partially or wholly within a designated tourism activity zone may disclose in writing to any prospective purchaser or lessee of the property that the subject property is located within a tourism development zone, with a description of the potential impacts associated with the parcel's location within a tourism activity zone.
