4. Title: Cemetery operators; written acknowledgment of itemized statement of charges and general price list.

5. Summary: This bill provides that whenever a general price list or itemized statement of charges in connection with burial services is provided to an individual, a cemetery company must obtain a written acknowledgment of receipt. Under current law, a general price list or itemized statement of charges is required to be offered with no acknowledgement of receipt.
