4. Title: Telephone billing practices.

5. Summary: Telephone billing practices. Exempts a telephone company from existing requirements regarding entering into billing agreements with third-party service providers or billing agents if the telephone company bills its customers pursuant to an executed contract. The measure also provides that a telephone company may not enter into a billing agreement with a third-party service provider or billing agent unless, in addition to the current condition that the third party be required to obtain verification of the customer's authorization for the charges, the telephone company notifies its customers whether or not free blocking of certain third-party vendor billing is available.
