It provides that the General Assembly may, however, by appropriate legislative action, add these employees to VaLORS. Without additional legislative authority, these employees will remain general State employees. As of June 30, 2012 there were 20 full-time employees of the Department of Military Affairs who provide fire protection services for facilities of the Virginia National Guard.
