4. Title: Scenic river designation.

5. Summary: This bill adds the 17.8-mile segment of the Meherrin River lying within Mecklenburg and Lunenburg Counties as a component of the Virginia Scenic Rivers System. The Meherrin River within Brunswick County, a distance of approximately 37 miles, adjoins the new segment and is designated as a scenic river by current law, making the total distance designated as a scenic river approximately 54.8 miles.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill has no state fiscal impact. The bill provides that nothing in the amended section shall preclude the Commonwealth or a local governing body from constructing, reconstructing, or performing necessary maintenance on any road or bridge.
