4. Title: State Board of Elections; Virginia Voter Registration System.

5. Summary: Directs the State Board to cooperate with other states to develop systems to compare voters and registration lists in order to ensure accuracy of voter registration rolls, prevent duplicate registration, and determine eligibility of individuals to vote.

8. Fiscal Implications: The State Board of Elections (SBE) reports that Virginia has paid the \$25,000 membership to participate in an interstate data sharing program known as ERIC, the Electronic Registration Information Center. SBE currently conducts similar activities required by the legislation and reports that the agency should be able to absorb the costs.
