4. Title: Deer; kill permits for towns.

Summary: This bill authorizes the chief law-enforcement officer of a city or town to report to the Director of the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries that deer are creating a traffic hazard in the jurisdiction. If after an investigation the Director finds that such a hazard exists, he may authorize responsible persons, or their representatives, to kill the deer.
