11. Other comments:

Current Law

Current law requires that, upon written request of the Commissioner of the Revenue, every person owning or operating an apartment house, office building, shopping center, trailer camp, trailer court, marina, or privately owned or operated airport in Virginia, as well as owners or operators of self-service storage facilities that make the outdoor common area of such facilities available for storage of tangible personal property on a rental or leased basis, file with the Commissioner of the Revenue a list that provides the name and address of every tenant of these properties as of January 1st. The owners or operators must provide such list to the Commissioner of the Revenue on or before February 1st of every year. In addition, upon written request of the Commissioner, condominium unit owners' associations and proprietary lessees' associations must provide a list of the owners of property it manages, to the extent it maintains such a list. Anyone failing to comply with these requirements is guilty of a Class 4 misdemeanor.

<u>Proposal</u>

This bill would require apartment owners and operators and property owners' associations to have each tenant or homeowner complete motor vehicle registration forms for submission to the local commissioner of the revenue, upon his request. The apartment owner operator and the association would be required to deliver or mail the forms to the Commissioner of the Revenue. Under the terms of the bill, the Commissioner would be authorized to allow the bills to be transmitted electronically.

The effective date of this bill is not specified.

Similar Legislation

House Bill 1957 would require the Department of Taxation to mandate that local commissioners of the revenue include a motor vehicle's make, model, year, and owner's name in the personal property tax book that lists all the personal property in the commissioner's locality.
