**4. Title:** Powers of the State Inspector General; legislative and judicial branches.

**5. Summary:** Powers of the State Inspector General; legislative and judicial branches. Authorizes the State Inspector General to conduct performance reviews of legislative and judicial branch agencies in addition to executive branch agencies; however, such reviews shall be limited to the statement of economic interests filed by state officers or employees and members of the General Assembly. The bill also provides that the State Inspector General shall evaluate the efficiency of such agencies as part of such review process and determine whether such agencies are accomplishing their mission.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** This bill expands the authority of the OSIG to include the review of *Statements of Economic Interest* filed by state officers or employees and members of the General Assembly. As such, this bill does not add any new mandates to the OSIG; rather, this bill expands the investigative tools available to the OSIG, and its enactment should not result in any fiscal impact to the agency.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** None.

**9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected:** Office of State Inspector General and public officials and employees who file Statements of Economic Interests with the Commonwealth.
