8.	Fiscal Implications: According to the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries, any fiscal impact resulting from this legislation is not quantifiable at this time. The proposed legislation adds another day to the hunting season's weeks. The agency expects an increase in dispatch call intake during the first year of implementation. In addition, the department may need to authorize overtime for conservation officers, or hire additional officers, to enforce provisions of this bill. Any impact, however, is expected to be minimal.
