4. Title: Recycled Materials in Highway Construction Advisory Committee.

5. Summary: The proposed legislation would eliminate the Recycled Materials in Highway Construction Advisory Committee. The committee was created in 1992 to make recommendations to the Department of Transportation (VDOT) on the use of recycled materials in roadway construction. The committee was specifically tasked with making recommendations to the Department of Transportation on the components of a five-year plan for encouraging the increased use of recycled glass and other recyclable materials in Virginia highway projects. The committee's report was due to the General Assembly in 1994.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: None.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The proposed legislation is not expected to impact state finances. The committee has not met in recent years and VDOT now typically uses recycled materials in construction projects.
