3. Committee: Passed Both Houses.

4. Title: Hunting and fishing; authorizes Board of Game and Inland Fisheries to issue trip licenses.

5. Summary: This bill authorizes the Board of Game and Inland Fisheries to issue trip hunting licenses to nonresidents and trip fishing licenses to residents and nonresidents for time periods and at costs determined by the Board. Current law allows nonresidents to purchase a three-day trip hunting license at a cost of \$40 and a five-day trip fishing license at a cost of \$10 and allows residents to purchase a five-day trip fishing license at a cost of \$5.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that this bill will not have a fiscal impact to the Board or the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries. Current statute already provides the Board with the authority to revise the fees of such licenses pursuant to Section 29.1-103; however, any revision in cost would require a legislative change to the Code.
