**3. Committee:** Passed both houses

**4. Title:** Transfer of property by VDOT.

**5. Summary:** The proposed legislation would authorize the Department of Transportation (VDOT) to exchange real property owned by VDOT in Albemarle County for a comparable parcel of privately owned property. The exchange will enable VDOT to replace a septic system, since the VDOT owned parcel is not suitable for the system's drain field.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** None.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Final. See Item 8.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The proposed legislation would authorize VDOT to exchange parcels of land with a private landowner to facilitate the replacement of a septic system at the Keene Area Headquarters. The provisions of the bill are not expected to impact state finances. The Governor also proposed an executive amendment to the introduced budget to authorize the transfer, which the House and Senate each adopted and passed in their versions of the budget.
