**4. Title:** Escort driver certification

**5. Summary:** This bill provides for the certification and regulation of escort drivers in the Commonwealth. The bill also adds a traffic infraction for impeding or disrupting vehicles operating under a hauling permit that requires an escort vehicle. The bill has a delayed effective date of January 1, 2014.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Preliminary. See Item 8.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The Department of Motor Vehicles will incur one-time costs to make programming changes and will need to shift staff to support this program. However, this can be done within existing resources.
