4. Title: Escort driver certification

5. Summary: This bill provides for the certification and regulation of escort drivers in the Commonwealth. The bill also adds a traffic infraction for impeding or disrupting vehicles operating under a hauling permit that requires an escort vehicle. The bill has a delayed effective date of January 1, 2014.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of Motor Vehicles will incur one-time costs to make programming changes and will need to shift staff to support this program. However, this can be done within existing resources.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Department of Motor Vehicles, oversize/overweight haulers, escort car drivers.
