4. Title: Children; adoption assistance payment and post-adoption services for those adopted from foster care

5. Summary: The enrolled legislation requires the Department of Social Services to use all federal adoption bonus payments received by the Commonwealth to support post adoption services.

7. No Fiscal Impact

8. Fiscal Implications: The amount of federal adoption incentive bonus funds received by the Department of Social Services varies greatly from year to year. For example, the bonus amounts received in federal fiscal years 2010, 2011 and 2012 were \$16,000, \$53,647 and \$828,734 respectively. Moreover, there have been some years when no bonus funds were provided. As such, these funds are not included in the department's base budget allocations. The designation of these funds, as required in the enrolled bill, for post adoption services will have no fiscal impact on the department.
