4. Title: State Council of Higher Education for Virginia.

5. Summary: Changes the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia (SCHEV) by size and purpose expanding its purpose, and by requiring the presidents of the public institutions of higher education in the Commonwealth to present information and comment on issues of common interest at each meeting of the Council.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final, see item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The State Council of Higher Education for Virginia estimates that it will cost an additional \$4,000 per year to expand the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia council from eleven to thirteen members. However, SCHEV indicates it can absorb this cost.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: State Council of Higher Education for Virginia, colleges or universities required to participate in meetings.

11. Other Comments: The Senate submitted an amendment striking the language stating “have served previously as a rector, chair, or president of the governing board of a public institution of higher education in the Commonwealth.”
