4. Title: Clinical social workers; educational requirements for licensure

5. Summary: The enrolled legislation requires the Board of Social Work to accept proof of the successful completion of the following as evidence of the satisfaction of the educational requirements for licensure as a clinical social worker: (i) a master's degree in social work with a clinical course of study from a program accredited by the Council on Social Work Education, (ii) a master's degree in social work with a non-clinical concentration from a program accredited by the Council on Social Work Education together with successful completion of the educational requirements for a clinical course of study through a graduate program accredited by the Council on Social Work Education, or (iii) a program of education and training in social work at an educational institution outside the United States recognized by the Council on Social Work Education.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is expected that the proposal would require amendments to regulations which would be accomplished at scheduled board meetings. There may be a modest cost for constituent notification, a public hearing and an additional meeting of the regulatory committee.
