8. **Fiscal Implications:** The Virginia Department of Health (VDH) has indicated that there could be one-time expenses associated with reprinting the Virginia Guide to Family Planning, Genetics and Social Services booklet to remove the language relating to free ultrasound imaging and auscultation services. This legislation will no longer require VDH to annually research and publish a statewide list of public and private agencies and services that provide free ultrasound imaging and auscultation of fetal heart tone services. Approximately 30,000 family planning booklets are printed in both English and Spanish each year, and the proposed legislation would require the removal of the information relating to free ultrasound imaging and auscultation of fetal heart tone services. The annual cost to reprint the guide is approximately \$40,526 with an additional \$4,388 in distribution expenses. The total cost to print and distribute the guide would be approximately \$44,914.
