- 4. Title: Boards of Visitors of public institutions of higher education
- 5. Summary: The substitute legislation requires the appointment of one or more nonvoting faculty representatives to the local community college boards and boards of visitors of the four-year institutions of higher education. In addition, the legislation requires the appointment of one or more student representatives to boards of visitors of the four-year institutions of higher education and changes the number of board members that constitute a quorum from five to a majority of members.
- 6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.
- 7. Fiscal Impact: Preliminary. See Line 8.
- 8. Fiscal Implications: Current law permits, but does not require, such appointments. The substitute bill removes the option and requires local community college boards and boards of visitors of the four-year institutions of higher education to choose faculty representatives from individuals elected by the institution's faculty senate or other equivalent group of the institution. The substitute also requires boards of visitors to choose one or more nonvoting, advisory student representatives from individuals elected by the institution's student body, student government, or other equivalent group of the relevant institution. Further, the substitute changes the number of members that constitute a quorum from five members to a majority at the University of Virginia.

There should be little or no fiscal impact due to this legislation. However, any resulting expenses would be funded through the institution's or state board resources.
