4. Title: Assignment of certain staff in school divisions.

5. Summary: Permits local school divisions that employ a sufficient number of librarians, guidance counselors, and school-based clerical personnel to meet the staffing requirements prescribed in Standard 2 of the Standards of Quality (SOQ) to assign librarians, guidance counselors, and school-based clerical personnel to schools within the division according to the area of greatest need, regardless of whether such schools are elementary, middle, or secondary.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final. See item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that this legislation will not have a state fiscal impact since the SOQ methodology for funding librarians, guidance counselors, and school-based clerical positions remains unchanged.
