**4. Title:** State Inspector General; powers and duties.

**5. Summary:** State Inspector General; powers and duties. Grants additional powers to the State Inspector General relating to audit functions of state and non-state agencies. The bill reorganizes the State Inspector General's powers and duties and generally reorganizes the law relating to the Office of the State Inspector General. The bill contains technical amendments which clarify report requirements, administration of the Fraud and Abuse Whistle Blower Reward Fund, and provides inspections of and make policy and operational recommendations for state facilities and providers, including mental health treatment units in state correctional facilities. The bill also makes technical changes to language in the law establishing the Office of State Inspector General.
