**2. Patron:** Marsden

**3. Committee:** Courts of Justice

**4. Title:** Placement in secure local facility.

**5. Summary:** Reduces the time period during which a juvenile who has committed an offense that would have been a misdemeanor if committed by an adult may be detained in a detention home or other secure local facility from a period not to exceed six months to a period not to exceed 90 days. The proposal also clarifies that, if the juvenile is eligible for a commitment to the Department of Juvenile Justice, a suspended commitment must be imposed.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** According to the Department of Juvenile Justice, the proposal is not expected to have a fiscal impact since it appears to be consistent with current practices (most post-dispositional detention programs that take misdemeanor offenses already operate 90-day programs for these offenders).
