Summary: Reduces the time period during which a juvenile who has committed an offense that would have been a misdemeanor if committed by an adult may be detained in a detention home or other secure local facility from a period not to exceed six months to a period not to exceed 90 days. The proposal also clarifies that, if the juvenile is eligible for a commitment to the Department of Juvenile Justice, a suspended commitment must be imposed.
