3. Committee: Commerce and Labor

4. Title: Presumption as to death or disability of members of enforcement division of Department of Motor Vehicles

5. Summary: The bill would add full-time sworn members of the enforcement division of the Department of Motor Vehicles to those public safety employees who are entitled to presumptions that hypertension, heart disease, and certain infectious diseases are occupational diseases compensable under the Workers' Compensation Act.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate.

8. Fiscal Implications: Because the Commonwealth's Workers' Compensation Program premiums are experience-based, the Department of Motor Vehicles would be responsible for any increased costs for claims as a result of this legislation. However, DPB cannot estimate any fiscal impact associated with this bill with precision.
