4. Title: Voting by military and overseas citizens; pilot program.

5. Summary: Authorizes the Secretary of the State Board of Elections to establish a pilot program or demonstration project with the U.S. Department of Defense Federal Voting Assistance Program or other federal agency for the purposes of allowing members of the military on active duty and their spouses, citizens residing outside of the United States, and military voters with disabilities or injuries to vote absentee by secure electronic means or other new technologies.

8. Fiscal Implications: The State Board of Elections (SBE) reports that this legislation should not have a material fiscal impact on SBE.
