3. Committee: Senate Committee on Rehabilitation and Social Services

4. Title: Alcoholic beverage control; mixed beverage licenses for certain properties.

5. Summary: Provides that the Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) Board may grant a mixed beverage license, notwithstanding the requirement for a referendum, to properties (i) located as of December 1, 2012, within the Montgomery County Route 177 Urban Development Area, which area is adjacent to Exit 109 on Interstate 81, and (ii) on property fronting Route 603 with portions fronting on Interstate 81, located approximately 1,100 feet from the intersection of Route 603 and Interstate 81 at Exit 128 in Montgomery County.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control, the implementation of the requirements of this legislation is not expected to have a material fiscal impact on agency resources.

11. Other Comments: § 4.1-124 of the Code of Virginia requires the passage of a local referendum to permit the sale of mixed beverages in any town, county, or supervisor's election district of a county.
