4. Title: Voter registration; final day of registration and mail registration application.

5. Summary: Provides that the principal office of the registrar and other registration sites shall close for registration purposes at 5:00 p.m. on the final day for registration before an election. The same deadline shall apply to receiving mail registration, other than applications returned through the United States Postal Service.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The State Board of Elections (SBE) reports that this legislation will have no fiscal impact to the agency. SBE does indicate that localities and other government agencies normally closing before 5:00 pm may experience an increase in costs to stay open longer, but those costs should be minimal.
