Summary:** Provides that the principal office of the registrar and other registration sites shall close for registration purposes at 5:00 p.m. on the final day for registration before an election. The same deadline shall apply to receiving mail registration, other than applications returned through the United States Postal Service.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The State Board of Elections (SBE) reports that this legislation will have no fiscal impact to the agency. SBE does indicate that localities and other government agencies normally closing before 5:00 pm may experience an increase in costs to stay open longer, but those costs should be minimal.
