WHEREAS, Commander Basley retired from Cheatham Annex, now part of Naval Weapons Station Yorktown, the United States Navy's premier weapons facility, in 1979; and

WHEREAS, Commander Basley remained committed to the well-being of his fellow veterans as a member of Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 4639; and

WHEREAS, Commander Basley took an active role in community affairs through his association with various organizations, including Drive Safe in York County and the Colonial Area Republican Men's Association; and

WHEREAS, a man of integrity, Commander Basley served his community and country with great intelligence and dedication, and he leaves behind a legacy of service that others may strive to emulate;

WHEREAS, Raymond Basley will be fondly remembered and greatly missed by his wife, Shirley; children, Randall, Reed, Allison, and Sheena, and their families; and numerous other family members and friends; now, therefore, be it
