16 WHEREAS, Brenda Andrews, who joined the *New Journal and Guide* as the publisher's assistant in 17 1982, currently serves as the publisher and owner of the newspaper; and

 20 four Wendell Willkie Awards for outstanding journalism; and

WHEREAS, the *New Journal and Guide* will celebrate its 113th anniversary and the 30th anniversary of its publisher and owner, Brenda Andrews, at The 113 Thirty Celebration on April 13, 2013, at the Chesapeake Conference Center; now, therefore, be it
