9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That § 46.2-1024 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 46.2-1024. Flashing or steady-burning red or red and white warning lights.
12	Any member of a fire department, volunteer fire company, or volunteer rescue squad, any ambulance
13	driver employed by a privately owned ambulance service, and any police chaplain may equip one
14	vehicle owned by him with no more than two flashing, rotating, oscillating, or steady-burning red or red
15	and white combination warning lights of types approved by the Superintendent. For the purposes of this
16	section, a light is defined as a light bulb or bulbs encased and covered by one lens. Warning lights
17	permitted by this section shall be lit only when answering emergency calls. A vehicle equipped with
18	lighting devices as authorized in this section shall be operated by a police chaplain only if he has

18 lighting devices as authorized in this section shall be operated by a police chaptain only if he has19 successfully completed a course of training in the safe operation of a motor vehicle under emergency20 conditions and a certificate attesting to such successful completion, signed by the course instructor, is

21 carried at all times in the vehicle when operated by the police chaplain to whom the certificate applies.
