A BILL to amend and reenact § 23-108 of the Code of Virginia, relating to commissioned officers; tuition-free instruction.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 23-108 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 23-108. Commissioned officers may become students.

Any commissioned officer of the organized militia and Governor's military staff of ~~this the~~ Commonwealth may become a student at any state institution of higher ~~learning~~ education for a period not exceeding ~~ten~~ 10 months, and receive instruction in any or all the departments of military science, *emergency management, emergency services, public safety, and disaster management* taught therein without being required to pay any fee or charge for tuition.
