6	A BILL to require the Department of Social Services to convene a work group to develop a plan for
7	implementation of national fingerprint-based background checks for child care providers.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. § 1. That the Department of Social Services shall convene a work group to review current state and
10	federal laws and regulations governing criminal history background checks for all child care providers
11	in the Commonwealth and to develop a plan for implementation of national fingerprint-based criminal
12	history background checks for all child care providers in the Commonwealth, including
13	recommendations for statutory and regulatory changes and budget actions necessary to implement the
14	plan. Such work group shall include representatives of the Department of State Police, child day
15	programs licensed by the Department of Social Services, unlicensed child day programs, and other
16	stakeholders. The Department shall report its findings to the Governor and the General Assembly by
17	November 1, 2014.
