That §§ 55-79.83 and 55-513.3 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows: 10 § 55-79.83. Liability for common expenses; late fees. 11 12 A. Except to the extent that the condominium instruments provide otherwise, any common expenses 13 associated with the maintenance, repair, renovation, restoration, or replacement of any limited common element shall be specially assessed against the condominium unit to which that limited common element 14 15 was assigned at the time such expenses were made or incurred. If the limited common element involved 16 was assigned at that time to more than one condominium unit, however, such expenses shall be specially assessed against each such condominium unit equally so that the total of such special assessments equals 17 18 the total of such expenses, except to the extent that the condominium instruments provide otherwise. 19 B. To the extent that the condominium instruments expressly so provide, any other common expenses 20 benefiting less than all of the condominium units, or caused by the conduct of less than all those 21 entitled to occupy the same or by their licensees or invitees, shall be specially assessed against the 22 condominium unit or units involved, in accordance with such reasonable provisions as the condominium 23 instruments may make for such cases. The executive organ may impose reasonable user fees. 24 C. To the extent that the condominium instruments expressly so provide, (i) any common expenses 25 paid or incurred in making available the same off-site amenities or paid subscription television service to some or all of the unit owners shall be assessed equally against the condominium units involved and (ii) 26 27 any common expenses paid or incurred in providing metered utility services to some or all of the units 28 shall be assessed against each condominium unit involved based on its actual consumption of such 29 services. 30 D. The amount of all common expenses not specially assessed pursuant to subsection A, B, or C 31 hereof shall be assessed against the condominium units in proportion to the number of votes in the unit owners' association appertaining to each such unit, or, if such votes were allocated as provided in 32 33 subsection B of § 55-79.77, those common expense assessments shall be either in proportion to those 34 votes or in proportion to the units' respective undivided interests in the common elements, whichever 35 basis the condominium instruments specify. Such assessments shall be made by the unit owners' association annually, or more often if the condominium instruments so provide. No change in the 36 37 number of votes in the unit owners' association appertaining to any condominium unit shall enlarge, 38 diminish, or otherwise affect any liabilities arising from assessments made prior to such change. 39 E. Except to the extent otherwise provided in the condominium instruments, if the executive organ 40 determines that the assessments levied by the unit owners' association are insufficient to cover the common expenses of the unit owners' association, the executive organ shall have the authority to levy an 41 42 additional assessment against all of the units in proportion to their respective undivided interests in the common elements. The executive organ shall give written notice of any additional assessment to the unit 43 44 owners stating the amount, reasons therefor, and the due date for payment of such assessment. If the 45 additional assessment is to be paid in a lump sum, payment shall be due and payable no earlier than 90 46 days after delivery or mailing of the notice. 47 All unit owners shall be obligated to pay the additional assessment unless the unit owners by a majority of votes cast, in person or by proxy, at a meeting of the unit owners' association convened in 48 49 accordance with the provisions of the condominium instruments within 60 days of the delivery or mailing of the notice required by this subsection, rescind or reduce the additional assessment. No 50 51 director or officer of the unit owners' association shall be liable for failure to perform his fiduciary duty 52 if an additional assessment for the funds necessary for the director or officer to perform his fiduciary 53 duty is rescinded by the unit owners' association in accordance with this subsection. The unit owners' association shall indemnify such director or officer against any damage resulting from any claimed 54 breach of fiduciary duty arising therefrom. 55 F. It remains the policy of this section that neither a unit owned by the declarant nor any other unit 56 57 may be exempted from assessments made pursuant to this section by reason of the identity of the unit 58 owner thereof.

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G. All condominium instruments for condominiums created prior to January 1, 1981, are hereby
validated notwithstanding noncompliance with the first sentence of subsection D hereof, if they provide
instead that the amount of all common expenses not specially assessed pursuant to subsection A, B, or C
hereof shall be assessed against the condominium units in proportion to their respective undivided
interests in the common elements.

64 H. Except to the extent that the condominium instruments or rules or regulations promulgated 65 pursuant thereto provide otherwise, an executive organ may impose a late fee, *not to exceed the penalty* 66 provided in § 58.1-3915, for any assessment or installment thereof that is not paid within [$60 \ 3\theta$] days 67 of the due date for payment of such assessment. Except to the extent that the condominium instruments 68 provide otherwise, no such late fee shall exceed the penalty provided in § 58.1-3915.

69 § 55-513.3. Assessments; late fees.

70 Except to the extent that the declaration or any rules or regulations promulgated pursuant thereto **71** provides otherwise, the board may impose a late fee for, *not to exceed the penalty provided in* **72** § 58.1-3915, any assessment or installment thereof that is not paid within [$60 \frac{3\theta}{9}$] days of the due date **73** for payment of such assessment. Except to the extent that the declaration provides otherwise, no such **74** late fee shall exceed the penalty provided in § 58.1-3915.
