That § 15.2-5301 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: § 15.2-5301. Definitions. 11 As used or referred to in this chapter unless a different meaning clearly appears from the context: 12 13 "Authority" or "hospital authority" means a body corporate organized in accordance with the 14 provisions of this chapter for the purposes, with the powers and subject to the restrictions hereinafter set 15 forth. 16 "Bonds" means any bonds, interim certificates, notes, debentures, or other obligations of the authority issued pursuant to this chapter. 17 "City," means both cities and counties, and city-specific terms such as "mayor" shall be deemed to 18 19 also include the equivalent county term. 20 "Commissioner" means one of the members of an authority appointed in accordance with the 21 provisions of this chapter. 22 "Contract" means any agreement of an authority with or for the benefit of an obligee whether 23 contained in a resolution, trust indenture, mortgage, lease, bond or other instrument. "Cost," as applied to a hospital project, means all or any part of the cost of acquisition, construction, 24 alteration, enlargement, reconstruction and remodeling of a hospital project, including all lands, 25 structures, real or personal property, interest in land and air rights, the cost of demolishing or removing 26 27 any buildings or structures on land so acquired, including the cost of acquiring any lands to which such 28 buildings or structures may be moved, the cost of all labor, materials, machinery and equipment, 29 financing charges, interest on all bonds prior to, during and for a period of time not to exceed two years 30 after completion, provisions for working capital, the cost of architectural engineering, financial and legal 31 services, plans, specifications, studies, surveys, estimates of cost and revenues, administrative expenses, expenses necessary or incident to determining the feasibility or practicability of acquiring or constructing 32 33 the hospital project and such other expenses as may be necessary or incidental to the acquisition and construction of such project, the financing of such acquisition and construction and the placing of the 34 35 project in operation. 36 "Federal government" means the United States of America or any agency or instrumentality, 37 corporate or otherwise, of the United States of America. "Government" means the Commonwealth and the federal government and any subdivision, agency or 38 39 instrumentality, corporate or otherwise, of either of them. "Hospital project" or "project" means any and all medical facilities and approaches thereto and 40 appurtenances thereof. Medical facilities shall include any and all facilities suitable for providing 41 adequate hospital facilities and medical care for concentrated centers of population, and also includes 42 any and all structures, buildings, improvements, additions, extensions, replacements, appurtenances, 43 lands, rights in land, franchises, machinery, equipment, furnishings, landscaping, approaches, roadways 44 and other facilities necessary or desirable in connection therewith or incidental thereto, including, 45 without limitation, hospitals, nursing homes, assisted living facilities, continuing care facilities, self-care 46 47 facilities, medical office facilities, clinics, out-patient surgical centers, alcohol, substance abuse and drug treatment centers, laboratories, research facilities, sanitariums, hospices, facilities for the residence or 48 49 care of the elderly, the handicapped or the chronically ill, residential facilities for nurses, interns, and physicians and any other kind of facility for the diagnosis, treatment, rehabilitation, prevention or 50 51 palliation of any human illness, injury, disorder, or disability; together with all related and supporting facilities and equipment necessary and desirable in connection therewith or incidental thereto; or 52 53 equipment alone, including, without limitation, parking facilities, kitchen, laundry, laboratory, pharmaceutical, administrative, communications, computer and recreational facilities and equipment, 54 55 storage space, mobile medical facilities, vehicles, and other equipment necessary or desirable for the transportation of medical equipment or the transportation of patients. 56 "Obligee of the authority" or "obligee" includes any bondholder, trustee or trustees for any 57

bondholders, any lessor demising property to the authority used in connection with a hospital project or

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59 any assignee or assignees of such lessor's interest or any part thereof, and the United States of America 60

when it is a party to any contract with the authority. "Real property" includes lands under water, structures, and any and all easements, franchises and incorporeal hereditaments and every estate and right therein, legal and equitable, including terms for 61 62 63

years and liens by way of judgments, mortgage or otherwise. "Trust indenture" includes instruments pledging the revenues of real or personal properties but not conveying such properties or conferring a right to foreclose and cause a sale thereof. 64 65
